Entry Requirements

1. In order to participate in the promotion, persons must be a current financial member of Oatley RSL & Community Club and have their membership card inserted in a gaming machine at Oatley RSL & Community Club during the promotional period.
2. Entry is via computerised e-draw which will automatically award tickets to members at the rate of one ticket for every \$25.00 turnover.
3. The tickets will accumulate electronically.

Draw

4. The draw will take place:
 - a. Every Wednesday from 8.30pm.
 - b. Draw times:
 - i. Round 1 - 8.35PM, 8.40PM, 8.45PM, 8.50PM & 8.55PM
 - ii. Round 2 – 9.00PM, 9.05PM, 9.10PM, 9.15PM & 9.20PM
 - iii. Round 3 – 9.25PM, 9.30PM, 9.35PM, 9.40PM & 9.45PM
 - iv. Winners Round – 9.50PM
 - c. Tickets can be earned between 7.30PM and 9.45PM
5. The members name will be announced over the public address.
6. Members must be present to win, and the winning member must make themselves known to the official representative at Oatley RSL within 4 (four) minutes. If the member fails to do so in the 4 (four) minutes or is unable to meet all the terms and conditions of the Promotion, then another ticket is drawn until a winner is found.

Prizes

7. The Wheel is numbered 1 to 50.
8. The contestant has the opportunity to spin the wheel three (3) times and score the number they land on.
9. The contestant's final score is determined by the sum of the three spins.
10. For the spin to be eligible,
 - a. The contestant must "play it from where it stands" meaning they cannot adjust the wheel prior to spinning.
 - b. The wheel must complete at least one full revolution
11. The winner of each round will receive \$50 worth of bonus points
12. Winners Round commences immediately following the conclusion of Round 3 and is conducted in the following manner
 - a. Each of the three winners have a single spin of the wheel and score what number they land on.
 - b. The winner with the highest score receives \$100 worth on bonus points
 - c. In the event one of the round winners is not present for the winners round the contestant with the next highest score in that original round will replace the absent contestant in the winners round.
 - d. In the event two contestants have the same highest score, they will each take turns taking single spins until a winner is determined.
13. Winners cannot "redo" their go.
14. Bonus points prizes are awarded to the member's card.

General

15. Oatley RSL & Community Club reserves the right to cancel or change the prizes offered under this promotion if there were any changes to the law which would render the promotion or any prizes offered under the promotion unlawful.
16. Oatley RSL & Community Club reserves the right to alter the number of spins listed in clause 8 above, any alteration must be done before the 8.35PM contestant commences their spins.
17. The following persons are not eligible to win or participate in the Badge Draw:
 - a. Any employee of Oatley RSL & Community Club Limited, either currently employed or employed within the previous 12 months of the date of the draw;
 - b. Contracted and sub contracted employees of Oatley RSL & Community Club Ltd, as well as their employees, including but not limited to Club tradesmen and the owners and employees of the caterer, whose services have been engaged in the previous 12 months of the date of the draw;
 - c. Suspended members, or any member with pending disciplinary actions against their membership;
 - d. Any non-financial member; and

18. In the event that the winner is an individual listed in clause 17 above, a redraw will immediately occur.

20. The member whose number is drawn must be present in the Clubhouse at the time of that said particular draw (announcement).
21. Membership cards, numbers and entry tickets are not transferrable, and only the individual named and related to the winning membership number is eligible to claim the prize.
22. To the extent permissible by law, members release Oatley RSL & Community Club from any causes of action, loss, liability, damage, expense (including claim for legal expense), cost or charge sustained or in any way incurred, as a result of participation in this promotion.
