

Oatley RSL & Community Club Limited Guess the Eggs Competition Terms and Conditions.

The 2025 Guess the Egg Competition will run from April 1 and cease on April 20.

Entrants do not need to be present at the conclusion of the competition to win. The winner will be informed of their win via phone or email.

Rules and Conditions

In addition to the Conditions set out by the Department of Gaming and Racing the following approved rules and conditions apply:

- 1. The competition will run from 10am April 1 2025. Entries close 11.59pm April 20 2025
- 2. The competition is open to Members of Oatley RSL only.
- 3. Entry forms will be issued through the Wymac Members Kiosk
- 4. Members play the "Hoppy Easter" game to win entry tickets
- 5. Members can win up to a maximum of Three (3) entries per day
- 6. All entries must be placed in the designated barrel by 11.59pm April 20 to be eligible.
- 7. The Prize will be on display in the reception area for the duration of the competition.
- 8. Entrants must not open or tamper with the prize in any way.
- 9. Entrants do not need to be present at the conclusion of the competition to claim.
- 10. In the event that there are no correct guesses, the closest guess will win
- 11. In the event that more than one correct guess or equally close guesses submitted
 - a) All of the entry forms with a correct guess will be placed into a draw and one (1) form will be pulled out at random. That selected entry form receives the hamper.
 - b) The remaining entrants with a correct guess will receive \$50 in Club Cash which will be loaded onto their membership card.
