

Oatley RSL & Community Club Limited Market Day Raffle Terms and Conditions.

The Market Raffle is held on Thursday Afternoons. Ticket sales begin at 2pm and stop at 2.30pm. The draw begins once Trivia questions have been completed and will continue to be drawn until all prizes have been claimed.

The 'draw' constitutes the physical announcement of ticket number.

*Members must be present within and inside the physical **Clubhouse at the time of the draw (announcement) – a four (4) minute grace period to claim prize is then issued to members present in the Clubhouse should they be incapacitated at the time of the announcement.*

***The Clubhouse refers to the physical club building only situated at 23 Letitia Street, Oatley NSW 2232 and is not inclusive of Club carparks, footpaths, driveways, adjoining halls, buildings or properties.*

Rules and Conditions

In addition to the Conditions set out by the Department of Gaming and Racing the following approved rules and conditions apply:

1. The Market Day Raffle will be held once per week, on Thursday Afternoon
2. Raffle
 - a) Tickets will be sold from the bar and portable tills.
 - b) Sales will begin at 2pm and cease at 2.30pm.
 - c) The draw will commence once Trivia questions have been completed.
 - d) Numbers will be drawn until all prizes have been claimed
 - e) The Raffle consists of 27 prizes with a combined RRP of \$785.00
 - f) Winners can choose from any prize still available except for the \$100 Wish Card which is awarded to the last winning number drawn.
 - g) Senior management have the right in their sole discretion and without prior notice to alter the prize structure of the draw, under the same conditions and rules, provided the combined retail value of prizes remains unchanged
3. Trivia
 - a) Trivia consists of eight (8) questions
 - b) Trivia will commence from 2.30pm following the close of raffle ticket sales.
 - c) Patrons write their answers on the supplied Trivia answer sheet
 - d) Patrons can form teams of up to 10 people
 - e) Answer sheets to be collected and marked by staff
 - f) Answers to the questions are read aloud after the raffle
 - g) Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd are awarded
 - h) Trivia prize structure
 1. 1st - \$50 Club Cash Voucher
 2. 2nd - \$20 Club Cash Voucher
 3. 3rd - \$10 Club Cash Voucher
 - i) In the event of multiple teams on the same points, a virtual "Spin the Wheel" draw will take place to determine the winner
4. Second Chance Draw
 - a) Patrons will receive entry tickets to the second chance draw when purchasing raffle tickets
 - b) Second Chance Draw entry tickets will automatically print
 - c) 1x Second Chance Ticket per \$5 of raffle tickets purchased
 - d) 3x Second Chance Tickets per \$10 of raffle tickets purchased
 - e) The Second Chance Draw will consist of 3 numbers
 - f) The Winner will "Spin the Wheel" and receive the prize that corresponds to the number that they land on.
 - g) The Wheel must complete at least one (1) complete revolution to constitute a valid spin

- h) In the instance of an invalid spin, the patron may reattempt the spin until a valid spin has been completed.
 - i) A patron can only win a second chance draw once
 - j) In the instance of a patron winning a second time, that number will be redrawn.
 - k) The third and final number drawn can only be won by a patron who has not won a prize in the main raffle.
 - l) Does not include trivia prizes
 - m) In the instance of a patron winning and that patron has already won a prize in the main raffle, the number will be redrawn until a valid winner has been drawn.
5. End of Month Draw
- a) A Bonus Draw will be held on the last Market Day of the Month.
 - b) Consists of eight (8) \$50 Woolworths Wish Gift Cards
 - c) The Second Chance Draw Entries from that month will be placed in the barrel
 - d) One ticket will be drawn out at a time until all prizes have been claimed
 - e) A patron may only win one (1) prize
 - f) In the instance of a patron winning and that patron has already won a prize in the End of Month Draw Only, the number will be redrawn until a valid winner has been drawn.
6. The promotion will run from 1st January 2026 to 31st December 2027
7. To claim, patrons already present in the Clubhouse at the time of the draw must present themselves, and the ticket containing the drawn number to the raffle caller within a four (4) minute grace period
8. Unclaimed numbers will be redrawn.
9. The following persons are not eligible to win or participate in the Market Day Raffle:
- a) Any employee of Oatley RSL & Community Club Limited, either currently employed or employed within the previous 12 months of the date of the draw;
 - b) Contracted and sub contracted employees of Oatley RSL & Community Club Ltd, as well as their employees, including but not limited to Club tradesmen and the owners and employees of the caterer, whose services have been engaged in the previous 12 months of the date of the draw;
 - c) Suspended members, or any members with pending disciplinary actions against their membership;
 - d) Any member or guest under the age of 18 years.
10. In the event that the winner is an individual listed in clause 9 above, a redraw will immediately occur.
11. Directors, who act in accordance with these Terms and Conditions, are eligible to claim the prize.
12. By accepting the prize, the member agrees to participate in any publicity arrangements made by or on behalf of the Club in relation to this promotion. Oatley RSL & Community Club reserves the right to publicise the winners' names and photograph through print, electronic media and broadcasts without permission or payment of any compensation to the winner and without prior notification.
13. To the extent permissible by law, members release Oatley RSL & Community Club from any causes of action, loss, liability, damage, expense (including claim for legal expense), cost or charge sustained or in any way incurred, as a result of participation in this promotion.
14. Oatley RSL & Community Club in its sole and reasonable discretion may (but is not obliged to) cancel, suspend, terminate, modify or adjourn the promotion or any or all draws or any or all processes for the selection of any winner, where circumstances unexpected by the Club arise in relation to the promotion or a draw. Unexpected circumstances could include (but are not limited to) technical difficulties, power outages, computer virus, computer bug, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or errors, and any other unexpected circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the Club which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct as planned of the promotion. The Club's rights are subject to any direction given under any relevant legislation or in connection with any permit under which the promotion is conducted.

Oatley RSL & Community Club is not responsible for, and is not obliged to delay a draw or a process of selecting a winner because of any delay or impediment in connection with the admission of members or in the completion of entries to the promotion or in seeking to attend any draw or to attend the process of selecting a winner.
16. Oatley RSL & Community Club is not responsible for members being located in areas within the Clubhouse in which announcements are not able to be heard, nor for the audible integrity of those announcements.
